Over 200 people attended Or Echad's High Holy Day services last year! # The HomeShul Program

# Level 1:

The Level 1 Students are those who have not had any religious school training before. They will start with beginning Hebrew. The Judaica curriculum is primarily based on the rituals surrounding the major Jewish Holidays like Shabbat, Hanukkah, Passover, Purim, and Sukkot. Weekly Tefillah (Prayer) is time for singing, movement, sign language, and explanations of the meanings of the prayers. Snack time gives students a chance to schmooze with their friends, but it's also when they learn special blessings over their food.

# Level 2:

The Level 2 students are those who have completed at least one year of religious school training at HomeShul or elsewhere. Level 2 is a continuation of their studies in Hebrew, Tefillah, and Jewish holidays. In the Level 2 class, the students will also learn about the minor holidays like Tu B'Shevat, Yom Ha'atzmaut, and Lag B'Omer. These students also enrich their Jewish learning with more in depth study of Torah stories and the values they still teach us today.

# Level 3:

Students in Level 3 have usually completed two years of religious school training at HomeShul or elsewhere. Having learned the basic prayers, these students will study prayers specifically geared for B'nai Mitzvah, and continue to study Hebrew on an advanced level. Having mastered their knowledge of the Jewish Holidays and rituals, they will have the opportunity to choose Judaic Electives to study such as Jewish History, Israel-Past and Present, Prophets, Theology, Jewish Values, and others. (Students in grades 4-6 who will be starting their first year of Jewish Education will need to study privately either before entering this program or as a supplement to it.)

<u>All HomeShul classes</u> will have fun with experiential, project-based learning like creating a Havdalah set, baking challah, sharing a Tu B'Shevat seder, putting on a Purim Shpiel, going on field trips and so much more!

# Level 4: (Grade 7) Integrative B'nai Mitzvah Program

This special B'nai Mitzvah Program is for all 2017-2018 B'nai Mitzvah students **and their families**. Classes will include Tallit and Kippah Making, preparing for Mitzvah Projects, Torah Study, and more. (Please stay posted for more info regarding this program as it is available.)
